Executive Summary:

If approved the City will enter into a two-year reimbursement grant program with the DOJ Office of Justice Programs' Bureau of Justice Assistance Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program (BVP) Reimbursement Grant in the amount of approximately \$27,000.

The police department budgets for and purchases bulletproof vests each year as they are replaced due to expiration, wear and tear, or as new officers are hired. This grant program provides reimbursement to law enforcement agencies at up to 50% of their total vest expenditures for vest purchases for the next two years. The actual amount of funds approved may be slightly more or less.

The Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) created by the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Act of 1998 is a unique U.S. Department of Justice initiative designed to provide a critical resource to state and local law enforcement. The Office of Justice Assistance (BJA) administers the Bulletproof Vest Program.
