Executive Summary:

If approved, <u>Kingsport City Schools will have an additional \$87,640.00 to provide high-dosage/low-ratio literacy tutoring at three elementary schools for students who are struggling in the mastery of grade level academic skills and standards.</u>

The City has an ongoing relationship with Niswonger Foundation for the Project On-Track program which utilizes the TN All Corps Community Partner Grant to supply high-dosage/low-ratio tutoring for students who are struggling in the mastery of grade level academic skills and standards. During the 2025-2026 school year, the focus will be on literacy tutoring for grades 1-4. Students will be provided with the opportunity to attend a minimum of 30 minutes at least two times a week for 12 weeks each semester.

<u>A budget of \$87,640.00 has been established</u>. The allocation is listed below. <u>A Budget Ordinance will be forthcoming upon execution of the agreement.</u>
