Executive Summary:

If approved the city will <u>issue a purchase order to Patterson Pope</u>, <u>Inc. for storage systems at the Justice Center in the amount of \$916,788.50.</u>

The Justice Center Addition and Renovation Project is designed to <u>improve security and safety</u> while increasing the footprint for the present as well as for the future. Patterson Pope, Inc. is a <u>trusted resource</u> for the unique requirements for this project to include delivery and installation of mobile high-density <u>storage systems</u>, freestyle personal duty lockers, pass-through evidence lockers, and shelving for the various areas of the Police Department (1st floor of the Justice Center).

Patterson Pope, Inc. will <u>provide and install new Spacesaver storage systems using the Source Well Cooperative Agreement #110923-SPC</u> as referenced in their proposal letter dated August 7, 2025, and quote #Q-73967-1 in the amount of \$916,788.50.

As a member of the National Joint Powers Alliance, the <u>City of Kingsport can take advantage of</u> nationally leveraged competitively solicited purchasing contracts as allowed by TCA 12-3-1205, <u>Cooperative Purchasing Agreements</u>.
