Executive Summary:

If approved the city will issue a purchase order to Patterson Pope, Inc. for storage systems at the Justice Center in the amount of \$916,788.50.

The Justice Center Addition and Renovation Project is designed to improve security and safety while increasing the footprint for the present as well as for the future. Patterson Pope, Inc. is a trusted resource for the unique requirements for this project to include delivery and installation of mobile high-density storage systems, freestyle personal duty lockers, pass-through evidence lockers, and shelving for the various areas of the Police Department (1st floor of the Justice Center).

Patterson Pope, Inc. will provide and install new Spacesaver storage systems using the Source Well Cooperative Agreement #110923-SPC as referenced in their proposal letter dated August 7, 2025, and quote #Q-73967-1 in the amount of \$916,788.50.

As a member of the National Joint Powers Alliance, the City of Kingsport can take advantage of nationally leveraged competitively solicited purchasing contracts as allowed by TCA 12-3-1205, Cooperative Purchasing Agreements.
