BANCROFT CHAPEL ANNEXATION SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

In November 2024, Michael Bare requested annexation of his property at 226 Bancroft Chapel Rd.

- This property is not currently served by public sanitary sewer.
- To serve this property adequately with sanitary sewer we need to extend the sewer line about 1,300 ft. from the existing system on Bancroft Chapel Rd.

<u>The cost to extend this sewer is estimated at \$375,000</u>. The development is planned to have 40-45 homes when fully developed.

- Our anticipated annual sewer revenue per lot is \$583.20.
- Using this revenue estimate over 16 years for a reasonable break even period, each new residence would provide \$9,331.20 in sewer revenue.

The agreement requires the developer to build at least <u>40 homes within 5 years</u>, ensuring we receive adequate revenue to cover our costs.

- If fewer than 40 homes are completed, the developer must pay us back for any missing units.
- The <u>developer would need to provide surety for the full estimated cost of construction</u> for a minimum period of 5 years to reimburse the city in case of default.
