The City of Kingsport requests Clean Water State Revolving Funds for the above-referenced project. The estimated cost for the project is \$2,700,000.

This project is a replacement to the existing Pendragon pump station to provide a 1,000-GPM peak capacity system with three submersible chopper pumps (on VFDs), standby generator and flow meter. Aproximately 70 linear feet of a new 8-inch forcemain coming from the new valve vault and tying into an existing sanitary sewer manhole east of the new pump station. Approximately 29 linear feet of new 12-inch PVC gravity sewer line and three new 5-foot diameter manholes.
