A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE AGREEMENT FOR
TEMPORARY EMPLOYMENT SERVICES WITH LUTTRELL AND
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT FOR
THE SAME AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND
PROPER TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THE
AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, in February, 2023, the board approved an agreement with Luttrell for temporary employment services; and

WHEREAS, the agreement was for three years effective January 1, 2023, with a renewal option in annual increments after the initial term has expired; and

WHEREAS, the city would like to renew the agreement for the term of January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026, with no increase in cost or change to the services for the requested extension for 2026; and

WHEREAS, funding is identified various city accounts.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the renewal of the agreement with Luttrell for temporary employment services for calendar year 2026, is approved.

SECTION II. That the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice mayor, is authorized and directed to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, the city's renewal of the Agreement for Services and all documents necessary and proper to effectuate the purpose of the agreement.

SECTION III. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort and prosperity of the public.

SECTION IV. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
