WHEREAS, funding for this equipment is available in project # GP2402.

SECTION I. That the city manager is authorized to execute a purchase order to Patterson-Pope, Inc for the purchase of storage systems and related components as well as installation of the same for the Justice Center addition and renovations utilizing Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Agreement # 110923-SPC, in the amount of \$916,788.50.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
