Executive Summary:

If approved, this resolution will execute an agreement and <u>renew</u> our participation in an <u>Interlocal Cooperation Agreement allowing the city's police department to be a member of the Second Judicial District Drug Task Force.</u>

The Kingsport Police Department has had a long and successful partnership as a Second Judicial Drug Task Force (DTF) member. The Task Force is comprised of selected officers within the Sullivan County Sheriff's Office, Bristol, Tennessee Police Department, and Kingsport Police Department. The purpose of the DTF is to consolidate the effort, information, experience, and resources of member agencies for the effective investigation of drug cases.

The DTF is governed by the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement and a board of directors comprised of the chief law enforcement officer for each participating city and Sullivan County.

This agreement will continue to allow KPD to be a member of the Task Force, consolidating efforts, information, experience, and resources within the district to investigate drug cases effectively. It does not prohibit KPD from investigating drug cases within the city limits.
