Executive Summary:

If approved, the City will use The Interlocal Purchasing System's (TIPS) Contract 23010401 with Tennessee Window Films to purchase security film for windows in the Civic Auditorium and Dobyys-Bennett Science & Technology Center at a cost of \$82,571.68.

During recent years, the City built and opened a large new section at Dobyys-Bennett High School, the Science and Technology Center, which can house approximately 400 students. Much of this portion of the building is entirely glass exterior and a fragmentation film is needed at a minimum on the first floor. While the entry lobby of this building has fragmentation film, the remainder does not. Adding the film will provide greater security for the high school as a whole. Last year, the City transferred ownership of the Civic Auditorium to Schools for physical education classes while the dome was being rebuilt. To add security for classrooms at the Civic Auditorium, fragmentation film is needed.

The majority of funding for this project will be from the Public-School Security grant (\$75,874.76), which is a one-time, non-recurring grant to support Tennessee public school efforts in enhancing school safety for their students and staff. The remaining funding (\$6,696.92) will come from Schools General Purpose Funds. The Board of Education approved this purchase on November 11, 2025.
