Below are references in the well-known WI DOJ compliance guide for attorney-client privilege documents NOT being public records:

• Exempt from disclosure by state court decisions. "Substantive common law principles construing the right to inspect, copy or receive copies of records shall remain in effect." 214 For example:

Page 30: Records rendered confidential by the attorney-client privilege.221

### **Attorney Client is not subject to the balancing test:**

**Page 33**: Caution: Unlike the other privileges, the attorney-client privilege (**Wis. Stat. § 905.03**) does provide sufficient grounds to deny access without resorting to the balancing test.242

This is because the attorney-client privilege "is no mere evidentiary rule. It restricts professional conduct." 243

## • Privacy and reputational interests

**Page 37**: Privacy-related concerns may outweigh the public interest in disclosure if disclosure would threaten both personal privacy and safety, or if other privacy protections have been established by law (for example, attorney-client privilege).274
