An Ordinance Amending the Code of the Village of Kronenwetter
Part II: General Legislation
Chapter 200 - Animals
Article II. Licensing & Regulations
Amending Section 200-14 Fees – Subsection A

The Village Board of the Village of Kronenwetter do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Part II: General Legislation, Chapter 200 Animals, Article II. Licensing and Regulations, Section 200-14 Fees, Subsection A of the Code of the Village of Kronenwetter is hereby repealed and replaced to provide as follows:

Section. 200-14 (A) – Fees.

License – Fees. A license shall be issued under Wis. Stat. § 174.05 after showing evidence of rabies vaccination and payment of the applicable fee set by the Village Board:

- (1) For each dog spayed or neutered: a fee set by the Village Board.
- (2) For each intact dog: a higher fee set by the Village Board.

For (1) evidence of neutering, spaying or other method of rendering the animal sterile, from a licensed veterinarian, will be required.

Exception. License fees shall not be required for every dog specially trained to lead blind or deaf persons or to provide support for mobility-impaired persons. Every person owning such a dog shall receive annually a free dog license upon application to the Village.

Late fee. The Treasurer or his/her Deputy shall assess and collect a late fee set by the Village Board if the owners fails to obtain a license prior to April 1, of each year.

Duplicate License. A duplicate license may be obtained upon payment of a replacement fee set by the Village Board.

Use by another animal. No person may use any license for any other animal than that licensed.

Section 2: If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is found invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the provision or application of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 3: All ordinances and/or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of adoption and notice to the public as required by law.

Section 5: Village personnel are hereby authorized and directed to make all changes to the Village Code necessary to reflect this amendment.
