I just had a meeting with my design team on the final document I was waiting for in order to submit – so this should be in your hands in the next few days.

There were some delays with the fabrication shop – they're actually 52-54 weeks out for delivery and we had to find a new shop in order to meet the timelines for delivery.

As I noted in my previous email, I cannot give a delivery date for the tanks without approval of the submittal package, as that is required before we can secure the fabrication schedule.
