AGENDA ITEM: Installing stop signs on Kowalski Rd.

OBJECTIVE(S): To have the committee discuss the possibility of installing stop signs on Kowalski Rd.

HISTORY/BACKGROUND: In our previous CLIPP meetings we have received concerns about speeding and large trucks going down Kowalski Rd. An idea was presented about installing STOP signs at various intersections to control the speed and deter the vehicles from using Kowalski Rd. With the traffic data which shows the speeds and traffic counts, as well as the State of Wisconsin MUTCD with standards on regulatory signage, it is recommended that we do not install STOP signs to control speeds. STOP signs are only used to control intersections with high traffic counts or high crash data.
