

Wisc. Stat. 7.30 (6)(a) explicitly states, "the appointed election officials shall hold office for 2 years and until their successors are appointed and qualified. They shall serve at every election held in their ward during their term of office." Additionally, state law is clear that Republican Party, as well as Democrat Party, election inspectors must be used to staff polling places before any unaffiliated election inspectors. Wis. Stat. §§ 7.30(2)(a) and (4)(c).

The Republican Party of Wisconsin wants to ensure each and every Republican Election Inspector nominated in November of 2025 and thereafter appointed in December of 2025, consistent with <u>Wisc. Stat. 7.30 (4)</u>, are working all 2026 elections, as long as positions are available and before any unaffiliated election inspectors are scheduled. We completely understand if someone is neglecting their duties or any matter compliant with <u>Wisc. Stat. 7.30 (6)(c)</u>, but any malfeasance or concern must be communicated directly with the respective election inspector.

Wisconsin Elections are an open and public process with statutory opportunities provided to political parties to participate in that process. The Republican Party of Wisconsin will encourage Wisconsinites to participate in that process and will protect those who chose to do so.

For example, Recker v. City of Appleton, highlighted that if Republicans are made available to work they must be given the opportunity to do so and, further, Hendrickson v. City of Racine, enshrined the requirements to contact each and every political party nominee to see if and when they could be trained and what elections they can work through 2025. The Republican Party of Wisconsin will continue to fight for the right of Republicans to participate in the administration of our elections.

We thank you for your commitment to serve Wisconsinites across this state and look forward to continuing our work together. Elections are the most important way Wisconsinites can participate in the democratic process, and you are entrusted in administering them with the utmost integrity.
