These funds are used towards projects and donations throughout the year. This year, we are seeking permission to temporarily close the following roads on the following dates of the festival:

Arts and Craft Show:

- N. Woodhull Rd. between Grand River and McClintock St. from 8:00am on Friday, May 23rd to 8:00pm on Sunday, May 25th

Parade:

- Grand River Rd between Woodbury Rd. and Woodhull Rd from 10:30am to 12:00am (or end of parade) on Saturday, May 24th.

These closures are vital to ensuring the safety and enjoyment of our festivalgoers and to facilitate the various events planned, including parade, performances, and vendor activities. We have and will continue to coordinate with law enforcement, emergency services, and other relevant parties to ensure that proper safety measures and detours will be in place during these closures.
