

RESOLUTION NO 2026-033

CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF POLICE SERVICE DOG, K-9 BRAVO, TO THE CITY BY A THIRD PARTY; MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS OF FACT IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY ACCEPTING SAID DONATION; RECOGNIZING THE AUTHORITY OF THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SUCH DOCUMENTS AS ARE NECESSARY TO ACCEPT SAID DONATION AND TRANSFER OWNERSHIP OF K-9 BRAVO; REPEALING ALL PRIOR RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Lake City Police Department (the "Department") is a department of the City of Lake City (the "City"); and

WHEREAS, the Department is in need of a replacement K-9 which would cost the City approximately \$5000-\$7500 from fiscal year 2025-2026 budgeted funds; and

WHEREAS, a third party has offered to donate to the City K-9 Bravo, a four year old male German Shepherd; and

WHEREAS, K-9 Bravo would be trained to assist officers of the Department in drug detection and felony apprehension; and

WHEREAS, accepting the donation of K-9 Bravo would minimize expenditures by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City finds such donation is in the public or community interest and for public welfare; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lake City, Florida:

1. Accepting the donation of K-9 Bravo to the City is in the public or community interest and for public welfare; and
2. In furtherance thereof, the donation of K-9 Bravo to the City should be and is accepted by the City Council of the City of Lake City; and
3. The Mayor of the City of Lake City is the officer of the City duly designated by the City's Code of Ordinances to enforce such rules and regulations as are adopted by the City Council of the City of Lake City; and

4. The Mayor of the City of Lake City is authorized and directed to execute on behalf of and bind the City to such documents as are necessary to accept the donation of K-9 Bravo and complete the transfer of ownership of K-9 Bravo to the City; and
5. All prior resolutions of the City in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict; and
6. This resolution shall become effective and enforceable upon final passage by the City Council of the City of Lake City.


