<p><b>Summary Explanation &amp; Background:</b></p> <p>The City applied for and received a Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Springs Grant and a Legislative Appropriation Grant, which were combined for \$2,697,456 to fund the Wastewater Improvements of I-75 &amp; SR-47 Interchange Phase 1. Due to delays in bidding and other factors, a request to extend the grant deadline was requested and approved by the FDEP Grant Manager.</p> <p>In addition, because of the volatility of the market, some items/materials for this project were pre-ordered, with FDEP approval, and the City had to request for a new budget category be added to the grant agreement in order to be reimbursed by FDEP per the grant specifications. This was also requested of the FDEP Grant Manager and approved.</p>
