1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8	AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE POLICE OFFICERS' PENSION PLAN BOARD OF TRUSTEES; AMENDING CHAPTER 70, ARTICLE IV, OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED "POLICE OFFICERS' PENSION PLAN AND TRUST FUND"; AMENDING SECTION 70-93 TO CHANGE THE TERMS OF TRUSTEES OF THE PENSION PLAN BOARD OF TRUSTEES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
10 11 12	WHEREAS, the City of Lake City, Florida (the "City") has created a Police Officers' Pension Plan (the "Plan") which is codified in the City Code of Ordinances (the "Code") at Chapter 70, Article IV; and
13 14	WHEREAS , the Plan is administered by a Board of Trustees (the "Board") pursuant to Section 70-93 of the Code; and
15 16	WHEREAS , the Board has recommended to the City Council the Code be amended to provide for 4-year terms for the trustees of the Board; and
17 18	WHEREAS , the City Council of Lake City finds the provisions of this Ordinance are in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and others within Lake City.
19 20 21 22	WHEREAS , the City Council, being fully advised of the facts and circumstances, hereby finds it necessary and in the interest of prudent management of the City's affairs, and in the furtherance of the interests and welfare of the City to amend the Code to provide for 4-year terms for trustees of the Board; now, therefore
23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA:
24 25	SECTION 1. POLICE OFFICERS' PENSION PLAN AND TRUST FUND – ADMINISTRATION OF THE RETIREMENT PLAN
26 27	Chapter 70, Section 70-93(c) of the City of Lake City Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:
28	Sec. 70-93 Administration of the retirement plan.
29	* * *
30	(c) All trustees shall serve a term of <u>four</u> two years. If a vacancy shall occur prior
31 32	to the expiration of a member's term, a replacement member shall be chosen in the same manner as the person who has left office. A replacement trustee shall
3/	the same manner as the berson who has left office. A replacement trustee shall

serve a full term measured from the date of replacement. All trustees shall serve 33 34 until their replacements are selected. * * * 35 **SECTION 2.** 36 CODIFICATION 37 It is the intention of the City Council of the City of Lake City that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lake City, 38 Florida. The Sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered, re-lettered and the word 39 "Ordinance" may be changed to "Section", "Article" or such other word or phrase in order to 40 accomplish such intention. The correction of typographical errors which do not affect the 41 intent or substance of the ordinance may be authorized by the City Clerk or the City Clerk's 42 designee with the consent of the City Attorney without public hearing, by filing a corrected or 43 44 re-codified copy of the same with the City. 45 SECTION 3. REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT 46 All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are, to the extent they conflict with this Ordinance, repealed. 47 **SECTION 4. PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY** 48 49 It is the declared intent of the City Council of the City of Lake City that, if any section, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held or declared to be 50 unconstitutional, void, or inoperative by a court or agency of competent jurisdiction, such 51 52 holding of invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance and the remainder of this Ordinance, after the exclusion of such part or parts, shall 53 54 be deemed to be valid. 55 **SECTION 6.
