A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA APPROVING THAT CERTAIN AMENDMENT TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN THE AMONT OF \$430,833.00 FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A HANGAR BUILDING AT LAKE CITY GATEWAY AIRPORT; FINDING THE CITY IS ELIGIBLE FOR AND REQUESTED A RURAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE WAIVER PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE 288.0656; MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS OF FACT IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY APPROVING SAID AMENDED AGREEMENT; RECOGNIZING THE AUTHORITY OF THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND BIND THE CITY TO SAID AMENDED AGREEMENT; DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND BIND THE CITY TO SAID AMENDED AGREEMENT; REPEALING ALL PRIOR RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Lake City ("City") operates the Lake City Gateway Airport ("Airport"); and

WHEREAS, the City entered into a Public Transportation Grant Agreement on April 3, 2024 ("Original Agreement") with the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("Agency") for the design and construction of a hangar building at the Airport ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the completion of the Project requires additional funds; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Agency have agreed to modify the Original Agreement as the City is eligible for and has requested a Rural Economic Development Initiative (REDI) waiver pursuant to Florida Statute 288.0656 ("Amended Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Agency is willing to grant additional funds in the amount of \$430,833.00 to the City through said Amended Agreement which is attached as an Exhibit hereto; and

WHEREAS, completing the Project by approving the Amended Agreement is in the public interest and in the interests of the City; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lake City, Florida:

- 1. Approving the Amended Agreement to accept the funds to complete the Project is in the public or community interest and for public welfare; and
- 2. In furtherance thereof, the Amended Agreement in the form of the Exhibit attached hereto should be and is approved by the City Council of the City of Lake City; and
- 3. The Mayor of the City of Lake City is the officer of the City duly designated by the City's Code of Ordinances to enforce such rules and regulations as are adopted by the City Council of the City of Lake City; and
- 4. The Mayor of the City of Lake City is authorized to execute on behalf of and bind the City to the terms of the Agreement; and
- 5. The Mayor of the City of Lake City is directed to execute on behalf of and bind the City to the terms of the Agreement; and
- 6. All prior resolutions of the City Council of the City of Lake City in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict; and
- 7. This resolution shall become effective and enforceable upon final passage by the City Council of the City of Lake City.

EXHIBIT A

Project Description and Responsibilities

- **A. Project Description** (description of Agency's project to provide context, description of project components funded via this Agreement (if not the entire project)): Design & Construct Hangar Building
- B. Project Location (limits, city, county, map): Lake City Gateway Airport/Lake City, FL/Columbia
- **C. Project Scope** (allowable costs: describe project components, improvement type/service type, approximate timeline, project schedule, project size): Design & Construct Hangar Building: As required by 215.971, F.S., this scope of work includes but is not limited to consultant and design fees, survey and geotechnical costs, permitting, construction inspection and material testing costs, mobilization and demobilization, maintenance of traffic, erosion control, demolition, pavement (access roadways, parking lots, and sidewalks), drainage, utilities, primary and back-up power supplies, building (foundation, structure, roof, MEP, drainage, and fire prevention and protection), pavement marking, lighting and signage, fencing and gates, aircraft tie downs, landscaping (including outdoor lighting), and indoor/outdoor security systems, including all materials, equipment, labor, and incidentals required to complete the building project. The Sponsor will comply with Aviation Program Assurances.
- D. Deliverable(s): Design & Construct Hangar Building

The project scope identifies the ultimate project deliverables. Deliverables for requisition, payment and invoice purposes will be the incremental progress made toward completion of project scope elements. Supporting documentation will be quantifiable, measurable, and verifiable, to allow for a determination of the amount of incremental progress that has been made, and provide evidence that the payment requested is commensurate with the accomplished incremental progress and costs incurred by the Agency.

- F. Transit Operating Grant Requirements (Transit Only):

Transit Operating Grants billed as an operational subsidy will require an expenditure detail report from the Agency that matches the invoice period. The expenditure detail, along with the progress report, will be the required deliverables for Transit Operating Grants. Operating grants may be issued for a term not to exceed three years from execution. The original grant agreement will include funding for year one. Funding for years two and three will be added by amendment as long as the grantee has submitted all invoices on schedule and the project deliverables for the year have been met.
