#### **CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 2023-099**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO CHANGE ORDER NUMBER TWO TO THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY AND SGS CONTRACTING SERVICES, INC., RELATING TO THE REPLACEMENT OF TWO EXISTING IN-PLANT REUSE PUMPS AT THE ST. MARGARETS WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY FOR A PRICE NOT-TO-EXCEED \$133,258.62.

**WHEREAS,** the City of Lake City, Florida, (hereinafter the "City") entered into a Contract Agreement (hereinafter the "Contract") with SGS Contracting Services, Inc., (hereinafter "SGS"), authorized by City Council Resolution No. 2022-090, for the rehabilitation of St. Margarets Wastewater Treatment Facility (hereinafter "St. Margarets") for a contract price of \$2,173,300.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council approved Change Order No. 1 to the Contract, pursuant to City Council Resolution No. 2023-084, for a decrease in the Contract price and for a time extension of the project completion date by sixty (60) days; and

**WHEREAS,** the in-plant reuse pumps at St. Margarets are used for wash down and foam control in the tanks, and have exceeded their useful life expectancy; and

**WHEREAS,** the City administration and SGS have determined that it is in the respective best interests to enter into Change Order No. 2 to the Contract for a price increase not-to-exceed \$133,258.62; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to enter into a Change Order No. 2 pursuant to and in accordance with the respective terms and conditions included in the attached correspondence, attached hereto as "Exhibit A", and made a part of this resolution to accompany a formal Change Order.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1**. The above recitals are all true and accurate and are hereby made a part of this resolution.

**Section 2**. The City is hereby authorized to enter into a Change Order No. 2 with SGS, for a price not-to-exceed \$133,258.62 and the Mayor is authorized to execute a formal Change Order No. 2 for and on behalf of the City.

**Section 3.** The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to make such reasonable changes and modifications to the Change Order as may be deemed necessary to be in the best interest of the City and its citizens. Provided however, that any such changes or modifications shall not cause the payment to SGS Contracting Services, Inc., to exceed the Contract Price. The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Change Order in the name of, and on behalf of, the City with such changes, amendments, modifications, omissions, and additions made by the City Manager and City Attorney. Execution by the Mayor and SGS Contracting Services, Inc., shall be deemed to be conclusive evidence of approval of such changes, amendments, modifications, omissions, and additions.

Part 1 (Centrifuge Feed Pump Motor Replacement):

Furnish and install new motors and VFD's for the centrifuge feed pumps, per the attached quote from the manufacturer's representative.

Part 2 (Plant Service Water Booster Pump Station):

Furnish and install new pipe, valves, fittings, appurtenances and pump skid to replace existing plant service water booster pump station. Includes demolition of the existing concrete pedestal due to new pump skid placement. Will make minor adjustments to pump suction/discharge height as required. Remove existing control panel and route power feeders to new skid-mounted control panel. Construct small equipment pad for remote-mounted bladder tank.
