Contractor is looking to pave Friday, June 9, 2023. ACC requested if they could leave the milled surface open for more than one day. The City Representative did not have any objection. They plan to start around June 5, 2023, with the grading, driveway aprons, and NE Simms Dr reconstruction area. The milling will begin sometime between the 6th and the 9th, with the paving planned for the 9th. Then there's some curb, and cross-slope corrections planned after the paving.

ACC requested to use RAP Base instead of Limerock Base for driveway and turnout construction. NFPS representative had no objection. Limerock will be used in full-depth reconstruction areas. Contractor advised black base is anticipated for the railroad exception areas.

The city requested when ACC will contact the Railroad. ACC will contact them as soon as they get the contact information. On 5/23/23, the EOR sent correspondence to the Contractor with points of contact for both FG&A Railroad and Norfolk Southern Railroad so they could contact them to procure flaggers.

ACC stated that all the milling and paving hinges on the flagmen that are required by the Railroad. The plan is to need the railroad flagmen for two days.
