

**CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 2022-069**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF A 2004 VACTOR TRUCK TO THE CITY OF HIGH SPRINGS; PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE PRICE OF \$8,000.00; PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF THE ASSET FROM THE CITY'S FIXED ASSETS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City administration of the City of Lake City, Florida (hereinafter the "City"), has determined that a 2004 vactor 2100 series (hereinafter "Property") owned by the City is not being used as initially considered at the time of procurement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has received an offer from the City of High Springs, Florida to purchase the Property for eight thousand dollars and zero cents (\$8,000.00); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that accepting the offer of the City of High Springs, Florida is in the best interests of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The above recitals are all true and accurate and are incorporated herein and made a part of this resolution.

**Section 2.** The Property described herein shall be sold and conveyed to the City of High Springs, Florida.
