AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE 1 2 OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY LAND DEVELOPMENT 3 REGULATIONS, AS AMENDED; RELATING TO THE REZONING OF TEN OR 4 LESS CONTIGUOUS ACRES OF LAND, PURSUANT TO AN APPLICATION, Z 24-5 02, BY THE PROPERTY OWNER OF SAID ACREAGE; PROVIDING FOR 6 **REZONING FROM COMMERCIAL GENERAL (CG) TO COMMERCIAL** 7 INTENSIVE (CI) OF CERTAIN LANDS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE 8 CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL 9 **ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, Section 166.021, Florida Statutes, as amended, empowers the City Council of
 the City of Lake City, Florida, hereinafter referred to as the City Council, to prepare, adopt
 and enforce land development regulations; and

WHEREAS, Sections 163.3161 through 163.3248, Florida Statutes, as amended, the
Community Planning Act, requires the City Council to prepare and adopt regulations
concerning the use of land and water to implement the comprehensive plan; and

16 WHEREAS, an application for an amendment, as described below, has been filed with the17 City; and

18 WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Board of City of Lake City, Florida, hereinafter referred

19 to as the Planning and Zoning Board, has been designated as the Local Planning Agency of

20 the City of Lake City, Florida, hereinafter referred to as the Local Planning Agency; and

21 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 163.3174, Florida Statutes, as amended, and the Land 22 Development Regulations, the Planning and Zoning Board, serving also as the Local 23 Planning Agency, held the required public hearing, with public notice having been provided, 24 on said application for an amendment, as described below, and at said public hearing, the 25 Planning and Zoning Board, serving also as the Local Planning Agency, reviewed and 26 considered all comments received during said public hearing and the Concurrency 27 Management Assessment concerning said application for an amendment, as described 28 below, and recommended to the City Council approval of said application for an 29 amendment, as described below; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 166.041, Florida Statutes, as amended, the City Council held the required public hearings, with public notice having been provided, on said application for an amendment, as described below, and at said public hearing, the City Council reviewed and considered all comments received during said public hearing, including the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Board, serving also as the Local Planning Agency, and the Concurrency Management Assessment concerning said application for an
 amendment, as described below; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined and found that approval of said application for
an amendment, as described below, would promote the public health, safety, morals,
order, comfort, convenience, appearance, prosperity, or general welfare; now, therefore,
