AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE 1 OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY LAND 2 3 DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, AS AMENDED; RELATING TO THE 4 **REZONING OF TEN OR LESS CONTIGUOUS ACRES OF LAND, PURSUANT** TO AN APPLICATION, Z 24-02, BY THE PROPERTY OWNER OF SAID 5 6 ACREAGE; PROVIDING FOR REZONING FROM COMMERCIAL GENERAL 7 (CG) TO COMMERCIAL INTENSIVE (CI) OF CERTAIN LANDS WITHIN THE 8 CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND 9 **PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE** 10

Planning Act, requires the City Council to prepare and adopt regulations concerning the use ofland and water to implement the comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, an application for an amendment, as described below, has been filed with the City;and

19 WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Board of City of Lake City, Florida, hereinafter referred to as

20 the Planning and Zoning Board, has been designated as the Local Planning Agency of the City of

21 Lake City, Florida, hereinafter referred to as the Local Planning Agency; and

22 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 163.3174, Florida Statutes, as amended, and the Land 23 Development Regulations, the Planning and Zoning Board, serving also as the Local Planning 24 Agency, held the required public hearing, with public notice having been provided, on said 25 application for an amendment, as described below, and at said public hearing, the Planning and 26 Zoning Board, serving also as the Local Planning Agency, reviewed and considered all comments 27 received during said public hearing and the Concurrency Management Assessment concerning 28 said application for an amendment, as described below, and recommended to the City Council 29 approval of said application for an amendment, as described below; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 166.041, Florida Statutes, as amended, the City Council held the
 required public hearings, with public notice having been provided, on said application for an
 amendment, as described below, and at said public hearing, the City Council reviewed and
 considered all comments received during said public hearing, including the recommendation of
 the Planning and Zoning Board, serving also as the Local Planning Agency, and the Concurrency
