Mr. Dyal,

I would like to submit a FRDAP application to add an R/C racetrack to the Richardson Community Center. Vested individuals in the community have been working on a plan to add this feature to the center for about a year. NFPS has provided a pro bono conceptual drawing for the project (attached) and the Richardson Community Center and Annie Mattox Park boards both concur that the project is a great idea.

Along with the addition of the R/C track, the FRDAP application will include the renovation of the playground adjacent to the placement of the track, and if the budget permits, a set of prefabricated restrooms to serve the park and track users. Addressing the playground and the restrooms will add several valuable points to the application.

I will be happy to provide a draft resolution for the City to approve at the next meeting. I will also be happy to attend the meeting to address any questions from the Council. To submit a successful application, I will also need the following:

1. A 30-year title search of the property by the City's attorney or property appraiser
2. A land survey of the property less than 3 years old
3. For additional points we can also present the project to local community organization for the purposes of public participation

Thank you so much for considering this project for the community. It will provide a new activity for our youth at the community center and from the community's input so far, we think it will be received well and add great value to the City's resources.



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
