

CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 2022-118

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA, FINDING AND DECLARING THE EXISTENCE OF AN EMERGENCY ARISING FROM AND OUT OF HURRICANE IAN.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida including its local governments have been made aware that Hurricane Ian may threaten the State of Florida and its various communities, including the City of Lake City, and endanger the safety and welfare of the citizens and their property; and

WHEREAS, based upon information, advice, and warnings from the various appropriate weather agencies, the City Council, in order to protect the welfare and safety of the citizens of the City and their property, finds it necessary to declare the existence of an emergency for seven (7) days and to make all precautionary and necessary plans to avoid or minimize damages arising from and out of Hurricane Ian.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above recitals are all true and accurate and are incorporated herein and made a part of this resolution.

Section 2. The City hereby finds and declares the existence of an emergency arising out of and from Hurricane Ian and authorizes and instructs all of the City officials and the various departments of the City to take all

emergency action which is prudent and necessary to protect the welfare and safety of the citizens of the City and their property.

Section 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to make emergency purchases of supplies and services required to prevent or repair damages resulting from Hurricane Ian.
