**SUBJECT:** Playground Equipment - Youngs Park (Piggyback - Omnia Partners)

<b>Recommended Action:</b> Approve a piggyback contract for playground equipment that is offered by Omnia Partners to purchase through GameTime.		
<b>Summary Explanation &amp; Background:</b> The City has received a quote from GameTime through the Omnia Partners cooperative purchasing contract (No. 2017001134), valid through December 30, 2026. This contract was competitively awarded and meets procurement requirements. The City proposes to utilize this contract to purchase new playground equipment for Youngs Park. Omnia Partners is a nationally recognized cooperative purchasing organization that provides access to pre-negotiated, competitively priced contracts. Several Florida municipalities, including Miami Springs, Homestead, and the City of Hollywood, have successfully used this contract. Leveraging this contract ensures cost-effectiveness and compliance while reducing the need for a separate bid process. This approach will significantly expedite procurement and project implementation and allow timely replacement of aging equipment at Youngs Park.
