**SUBJECT:** Taxiway C Realignment and Transient Apron Rehabilitation Grant Application Design Phase.

<p><b>Recommended Action:</b> Approve request for the Airport to apply for Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), Airport Improvement Program (AIP), grant FY2021 in the amount of \$166,520.00 The funds will be used toward Taxiway C realignment to meet FAA design standards and Transient Apron Rehabilitation.</p>		
<p><b>Summary Explanation &amp; Background:</b> Currently, Taxiway C connects the terminal apron to Taxiway A and connects Taxiway A to Runway 10-28 at an angle greater than 90-degrees. FAA design standards require a 90-degree connection. Design to realign Taxiway C at a 90-degree angle. Transient apron, approximately 350,000 sq.ft. of asphalt, was assessed and reported in very poor condition. Design to rehabilitate the apron to satisfactory pavement conditions. The Airport Advisory Committee met on May 13, 2021 and this solicitation of grant funds was discussed and recommended that this request go before Council for approval.</p>
