<p><b>Originator:</b> Paul Dyal</p> <table border="1"> <tr> <td><b>Interim City Manager:</b> Paul Dyal</td><td><b>Department Director:</b> Paul Dyal</td><td><b>Date:</b> 1-26-2022</td></tr> </table> <p><b>Recommended Action:</b> City Council consideration to approve amendment one (1) to the agreement LPR0016 between the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), an agency of the State of Florida, and the City of Lake City.</p> <p><b>Summary Explanation &amp; Background:</b></p> <p>DEP entered into the Agreement with the City of Lake City for Public Access Reuse/Chlorine Contact Chamber Upgrades, effective March 10, 2021. An extension of the Agreement is needed because of necessary modifications to the project and delays in materials.</p> <p>The City is currently working on another project, the Ichetucknee Quality and Quantity Enhancement Project, which will convert our existing pumped effluent disposal system to a gravity flow system and increase the recharge capacity of the City's constructed treatment wetlands.</p> <p>These include additional modifications to the PAR system, which will allow the City to send chlorinated effluent to the treatment wetlands in compliance with proposed FDEP requirements.
