CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AMENDMENT EXTENDING THAT CERTAIN ANNUAL AVIATION FUEL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND EASTERN AVIATION FUELS, INC., A NORTH CAROLINA CORPORATION DBA TITAN AVIATION FUELS; MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS OF FACT IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY APPROVING SAID AMENDMENT; RECOGNIZING THE AUTHORITY OF THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND BIND THE CITY TO SAID AMENDMENT; DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND BIND THE CITY TO SAID AMENDMENT; REPEALING ALL PRIOR RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2021, the City of Lake City (the “City”) approved an agreement for the annual aviation fuels annual contract at the Lake City Gateway Airport (the “Original Agreement”) with Eastern Aviation Fuels, Inc., a North Carolina corporation dba Titan Aviation Fuels (the “Vendor”); and

WHEREAS, the initial term of the Original Agreement was three (3) years with two (2) additional one (1) year extensions (the “Initial Term”); and

WHEREAS, the Initial Term expired on March 31, 2026 and the City and the Vendor mutually desire to extend the Original Agreement for ninety (90) days commencing April 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2026 by adopting an amendment to the Original Agreement (the “Extension Amendment”); and

WHEREAS, continuing to engage the Vendor’s services by approving the Extension Amendment is in the public interest and in the interests of the City; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lake City, Florida:

1. Continuing to engage the Vendor’s services by approving the Extension Amendment is in the public or community interest and for public welfare; and
2. In furtherance thereof, the Extension Amendment in the form of the Exhibit attached hereto should be and is approved by the City Council of the City of Lake City; and
3. The Mayor of the City of Lake City is the officer of the City duly designated by the City’s Code of Ordinances to enforce such rules and regulations as are adopted by the City Council of the City of Lake City; and
4. The Mayor of the City of Lake City is authorized to execute on behalf of and bind the City to the terms of the Extension Amendment; and
5. The Mayor of the City of Lake City is directed to execute on behalf of and bind the City to

the terms of the Extension Amendment; and

6. All prior resolutions of the City Council of the City of Lake City in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict; and
7. This resolution shall become effective and enforceable upon final passage by the City Council of the City of Lake City.

SERVICES EXTENSION AGREEMENT

THIS SERVICES EXTENSION AGREEMENT (the "Extension"), dated as of April ____, 2026 (the "Effective Date"), by and between the City of Lake City, Florida, a Florida municipality (the "City"), and Eastern Aviation Fuels Inc., dba Titan Aviation Fuels, a North Carolina corporation (the "Contractor")

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City and Eastern Aviation Fuels Inc. did enter into an annual contract effective March 31, 2021 (the "Original Contract") for Eastern Aviation Fuels Inc. to provide aviation fuel (the "Services") to the City for an initial term of three (3) years with two (2) one-year renewal options, for a total of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the Original Agreement was authorized by City Council on March 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the term of said Original Agreement ended on March 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City and Eastern Aviation Fuels desire to extend the Original Agreement for an additional 90-day period commencing April 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2026; now, therefore,

IN CONSIDERATION of the foregoing and of other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which hereby are acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Incorporation of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as material terms of this Extension and representations of the party to which such representation is attributed or to which such representation applies as if otherwise fully set forth herein.
2. Term of Contract. Item 4 of the Original Agreement between the City and Eastern Aviation Fuels shall be amended to read as follows:

The term of this contract will be extended by 90 days, commencing on April 1, 2026, and ending on June 30, 2026.

3. Remaining Terms. All other terms of the Original Agreement among the City and Eastern Aviation Fuels shall remain in full force and effect as if fully set forth herein.
4. Modification. No provision of this Extension can be modified or amended, waived, or discharged unless such modification or amendment, waiver, or discharge is agreed to in writing by both parties.
5. Disputes. This Extension shall be construed and governed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida. Except as expressly modified herein, all dispute resolution and venue provisions of the Original Agreement shall continue to apply.
6. Entire Agreement. This Extension reflects the entire understanding between the parties. Any written, printed, or other materials which the City provides to Eastern Aviation Fuels that are not incorporated in this Extension do not constitute a term or condition of this Extension.
