**BRIEF SUMMARY:** During their regular meeting on March 9<sup>th</sup>, the Marine Commission directed the Lake Advisory Board to study and make a recommendation regarding the use of wake boats, ballast systems, and wake surfing on the Lake. The LAB met and held discussion on this matter. They unanimously moved to recommend that the Marine Commission restrict wake boats for non-residents and limit wake surfing 200' from shoreline and structures.

In accordance with G.S. 166A-19.24, the Commission must wait a minimum of 24 hours to vote on a decision to allow adequate time for written public comment. This meeting should be recessed to a later date and not closed. A decision must be made within 60 days of the public hearing.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION AND REQUESTED ACTIONS:** To approve Resolution No. 21-05-11 amending the Lake Use Regulations.
