Background




- The Town is required to provide solid waste collection and disposal services
- The Town, through the PWD, operates an inhouse Solid Waste (Sanitation) Utility
- Collects solid waste from residential and commercial properties
- First line of defense for the health of the community




Recent Productivity



Residential Garbage Collection




Residential Recycling Collection



The Sanitation Fund



- Operates as a self-supporting Enterprise governmental fund
- Has historically fluctuated, borrowed from Reserves
- Impacted utility operation, rate stability, and planning for current/future needs
- Inconsistently covered the Utility's operating expenses



Sanitation Equipment



- Currently operates ten (10) trucks with an average years in service of
 7.8 Years
 - Nine of 10 trucks are <u>past</u> their recommended service life
- Results in frequent out-of-service periods and extended lead times for parts & service



Recent Sanitation Rate History



- No regular Rate updates until 2020, despite increasing operational costs
- Completed Sanitation Rate Study in 2020, recommended incremental rate adjustments
- Residential and Commercial Rates increased 9% in 2020
- Completed Commercial & Multi-Family Classes Rate Study in 2022
- Residential Rates increased by 10% in 2022
- Commercial Rates increased by 19.7% in 2022 (Commercial NAV also discontinued)

2022 Sanitation Rate Study



- Multi-Family Dwellings:
 - Currently, the Sanitation Code treats multi-family dwellings more favorably than single-family dwellings
 - Single-family/<5 unit multi-family dwelling = \$258.37</p>
 - >5 unit multi-family dwelling = \$174.97 (38.5% lower than single-family)
 - Multi-family (5 units or greater) w/ dumpster service: 88% (44 of 50)
 - Residential <u>Single-family</u> and <u>Multi-family</u> dwellings have differing solid waste generation rates and collection requirements

Multi-Family (5+ Units) Example





2023 Solid Waste Rate Study



Goals/Scope of Work for Rate Study:

- Data Request, Acquisition/Compilation, and Review
- Customer Sales, Revenue Forecast, Cost of Service Determination and Rate Design
- Development of Projected Revenue Requirements
- Prepare Solid Waste Rate Analysis Report



Next Steps and Key Dates



- March-April 2023: Complete Solid Waste Rate Study
- June 8, 2023: Public Workshop
 - Present study findings, rate recommendations
 - Discuss transition strategies for multi-family 5+, etc.
- June 21: Presentation of Report to Town Commission
- July 2023:
 - Coordinate with PBC Solid Waste Authority and Tax Collector's Office (the County) to remove Multi-family (5+ units) properties from tax roll
 - TRIM Cycle: <u>Maximum</u> proposed solid waste assessment rates due to the County (excludes dumpster fees)

Next Steps and Key Dates



August 2023:

Coordinate with HOAs to set up billing accounts

September 2023:

- Town Commission approves Master Fee Schedule for FY-24
- Tax Cycle: Final Solid Waste Assessment Rates due to the County

Oct 2023 (FY-24):

- Implement New Residential & Commercial Rates
- Begin billing HOAs' for Sanitation Services


