Summary Explanation/Background:

When possible, the Town of Lake Park allocates funds to its small and large grant program; small grants, which can be up to \$500, are for citizens of the Town, and large grants, which can be from \$500.01 up to the limit of available funding, are for local business and not-for-profit organizations. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, \$25,000 is allocated for the Town's grantmaking program. The Town received five applications requesting a combined total of \$70,020.

The five applications, along with summary overview sheets prepared by the Communications and Grants Department, are attached for review and consideration by the Town Commission in order to make funding determinations.
