

## **RESOLUTION 79-10-25**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH MEGAWATTAGE, LLC FOR PUBLIC WORKS GENERATOR ANNUAL MAINTENANCE & SERVICE PURSUANT TO RFQ 122-2025; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Lake Park, Florida (“Town”) is a municipal corporation of the State of Florida with such powers as have been conferred upon it by the Florida Constitution and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town is empowered to enter into contracts for goods and services necessary to maintain and improve public facilities, infrastructure, and operations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has identified the need for a qualified and licensed contractor to provide comprehensive generator maintenance services for three (3) town generators to ensure continued operational effectiveness; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town issued RFQ 122-2025 seeking competitive quotes for annual generator maintenance services, and Megawattage, LLC, submitted the lowest responsive and responsible quote in the amount of \$6,640.06, inclusive of the pricing, terms, and conditions in the RFQ 122-2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Commission desires to fund this purchase through the General Fund - Account 001-597-408-34000 - Contractual Services and proceed with the acquisition in accordance with the Town’s Procurement Policy.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein.

**Section 2.** The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute an Agreement with Megawattage, LLC, attached hereto as Exhibit “A,” for [goods/services] in the amount of \$6,640.06.

**Section 3.** Funding for this purchase shall be provided from 001-597-408-34000; any future costs associated with maintenance, warranty, or replacements shall be budgeted in subsequent fiscal years as necessary.

**Section 4.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
