

RESOLUTION NO. 81-10-2025

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH RUST TECH SERVICES, LLC, FOR WATER TREATMENT SERVICES FOR TOWN IRRIGATION SYSTEMS PURSUANT TO RFQ NO. 124-2025; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Lake Park, Florida ("Town") is a municipal corporation of the State of Florida with such powers as have been conferred upon it by the Florida Constitution and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Town is empowered to enter into contracts for goods and services necessary to maintain and improve public facilities, infrastructure, and operations; and

WHEREAS, the Town has identified the need for a vendor to provide, install, and maintain rust inhibitor systems at various locations within the town, including parks and parking lots; and

WHEREAS, the Town issued RFQ No. 124-2025 seeking competitive quotes for water treatment services for town irrigation systems, and Rust Tech Service, LLC submitted the lowest responsive and responsible quote in the amount of \$12,503.28, inclusive of all required labor, materials, delivery, permits, and applicable taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission desires to fund this purchase through the general fund (grounds maintenance) contractual services account no. 001-572-406-34000, and proceed with the acquisition in accordance with the Town's Procurement Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute an Agreement with Rust Tech Service, LLC, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," for water treatment services for town irrigation systems in the amount of \$12,503.28.

Section 3. Funding for this purchase shall be provided from general fund (grounds maintenance) contractual services account no. 001-572-406-34000; any future costs associated with maintenance, warranty, or replacements shall be budgeted in subsequent fiscal years as necessary.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
