Summary Explanation/Background: Care Crew Inc. is a 501 C3 group run by kids to focus on hunger, literacy, cleanliness, and loneliness. The group partners with various agencies, churches, and non-profit groups to improve communities.

In the school year 2022-2023, the group has been partnering with the Lake Park Library to create homework help and tutoring programs between 3:30 to 5:00 pm Monday through Thursday. The group also started a chess club on Fridays at the Library from 2:45 pm to 3:45 pm. Lastly, the group's Saturday slot started as a teen club and has evolved into an early learning time for children with crafts and educational games.

The Library once again is welcoming the group back for next year. Natalie Marx is the President of the Board of Care Crew, Inc. She is on hand tonight to provide a brief presentation to the Town Commission about the non-profit group.
