**Summary Explanation/Background:**

The Town's Public Works Department has identified, through the Town's Stormwater Master Plan (2019), that portions of the Town's stormwater system lack sufficient capacity to convey rainfall runoff from highly impervious urban areas during significant storm events. The Stormwater Master Plan identified multiple locations throughout the Town that experiences localized flooding, including Ilex Court.

As a result, the Town applied for a Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Resilient Florida Grant in the total amount of \$99,373 (with no Town match required). This grant award, if accepted, would assist in supporting the total cost to complete the engineering, design and permitting for the Ilex Court Green Infrastructure and Stormwater Improvements Project. The project will also include public outreach and stakeholder engagement and will assist in positioning the Town to apply for future construction funding opportunities.

The grant agreement term begins July 1, 2025, and expires June 30, 2028 and is administered on a reimbursement basis. The Town will be required to meet all applicable grant terms, reporting requirements and project deliverables as outlined within the Standard Grant Agreement.

If approved, the Town will immediately solicit an engineering firm provide design and engineering services for the proposed stormwater improvements.

The proposed grant agreement was prepared by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection and reviewed by the Grant Writer/Chief Public Information Officer, the Project Manager - Capital Projects, the Public Works Director, the Finance Director and the Town Attorney.

**Recommended Motion:**

I move to approve Resolution 36-05-26 and accept the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection's Resilient Florida Grant Award to support the Town's Ilex Court Green Infrastructure and Stormwater Improvements Project, in the amount of \$99,373 (No Town Match Required); and authorize the Mayor to execute the proposed Standard Grant Agreement.
