Summary Explanation/Background:

Ms. Amanda Kelsey Marion, a relative of Lake Park (formerly Kelsey City) founder Harry Kelsey and a part-time resident of Palm Beach County, visited the Town earlier this year and had an opportunity to play pickleball on the Town's courts in Kelsey Park.

As a result of this experience, Ms. Marion met with staff and expressed her desire to provide support to the Town through the Kelsey-Naylor Family Foundation in the form of a \$5,000 donation to be used to purchase benches at the pickleball courts. She also requested that a plaque, with the language to be discussed at a later date, be affixed to the bench(es) recognizing the donation.

Note: The \$5,000 donation was received by the Town in July 2026.

This generous gesture by the Kelsey-Naylor Family Foundation will improve Kelsey Park and provide a

lasting, tangible reminder of the Kelsey family's ongoing relationship with the municipality their ancestor created more than a century ago.
