Special Exception Request: Request for special exception to permit a "specialized Alzheimer's services adult day care center" which provides services to participants and their caregivers, and licensed for compliance with Florida Statutes 429.918. Applicant requests approval for special exception under the medical clinic use listed in Town Code, section 78-71 (2) (d) in the C-1 Commercial Business District. Applicant proposes to utilize 2,598 square feet of an existing 10,192 sq. ft. building.
