Summary Explanation/Background:

On November 2, 2022, the Town Commission adopted Resolution 78-11-22, which executed an agreement with All County Paving (Contractor) for the provision of maintenance and repair of streets, roads, and related services per the terms and conditions of City of Sunrise/All

County's Agreement No. 20200000111 (Cooperative Purchase).

Since October 2021, the department has utilized this competitively solicited contract to successfully replaced more than 1,100 linear feet of sidewalks at sixty-three (63) locations throughout the Town.

This agenda item is seeking approval to encumber/expend **\$119,997.25** of budgeted sidewalk repair funding to replace over **2,108 linear feet** of sidewalks at **fifty (50)** locations throughout the Town.

The work will also update two (2) crosswalk locations to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

Furthermore, the Contractor has informed staff that once authorized to proceed, they will mobilize to begin repairs within 30 days.

The Town Manager recommends approval.

Recommended Motion: I move to authorize the Town Manager to proceed with accepting the proposal from All County Paving for sidewalk repairs at multiple location throughout the Town.
