

RESOLUTION 16-02-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VICE MAYOR TO SIGN THE 19TH AMENDMENT TO THE PBSO CONTRACT, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas the Town of Lake Park, Florida (hereinafter “Town”) is a municipal corporation of the state of Florida with such power and authority as has been conferred upon it by the Florida Constitution and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes; and

Whereas Part I of Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, permits public agencies as defined therein to enter into Inter-local Agreements with each other to jointly exercise any power, privilege, or authority which such agencies share in common and which each might exercise separately; and

Whereas the 19st Amendment to the Sheriff’s contract provides for an additional PBSO Deputy Sheriff to replace the existing Motor Deputy, and

Whereas the Amendment will allow the Captain the flexibility to also utilize the deputy to perform both patrol and traffic duties as assigned by the Captain, and

Whereas the Town will also have the benefit of motor units as a contracted municipality of the Palm Beach County Sheriff’s Office; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT *RESOLVED*, THAT THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The whereas clauses are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

Section 2. The Town Commission authorizes and directs the Vice Mayor to execute the 19th Amendment between the Palm Beach County Sheriff’s Department and the Town of Lake Park, Florida for an additional Patrol Deputy.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon execution.
