Summary Explanation/Background: At the request of Captain Gendreau, the motor unit will be converted to a patrol deputy which will provide needed manpower to the patrol units in Lake Park. With the 19th amendment, Captain Gendreau will have a full complement of patrol deputies for all three shifts in district 10. Next year, the Captain was going to request an additional deputy which through the amendment will be on staff now rather than next fiscal year.

At the discretion of Captain Gendreau, and when manpower allows, Captain Gendreau will assign the patrol deputy to traffic enforcement. Furthermore, the district will have the

benefit of motor units as a contractee of PBSO when demand requirements necessitate motor patrols for the district.
