

RESOLUTION 80-09-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A DONATION FROM THE FRIENDS OF THE LAKE PARK PUBLIC LIBRARY, INC. OF FIVE (5) PIECES OF WOOD FURNITURE FOR USE AT THE LAKE PARK PUBLIC LIBRARY; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT SAID DONATION ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Friends of the Lake Park Public Library, Inc. (the “Friends”) is a not-for-profit organization that supports and enhances the programs, services, and facilities of the Lake Park Public Library; and

WHEREAS, the Friends have generously offered to donate to the Town of Lake Park (the “Town”) five (5) pieces of wood furniture, having an approximate combined value of \$4,445.16, for placement and use at the Lake Park Public Library (collectively, the “Donation”); and

WHEREAS, the Donation will enhance the comfort, function, and appearance of the Library for the benefit of Town residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town and its residents to accept the Donation from the Friends of the Lake Park Public Library.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Acceptance of Donation. The Town Commission hereby accepts, with gratitude, the donation from the Friends of the Lake Park Public Library, Inc. of five (5) pieces of wood furniture for use at the Lake Park Public Library.

Section 3. Authorization. The Town Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept the Donation on behalf of the Town and to take all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. Conflicts. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction,

such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
