

## **RESOLUTION 21-04-25**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO APPROVE A WORK ORDER WITH KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 FOR PLANNING AND ENGINEERING STUDIES PERTAINING TO THE PARK AVENUE DOWNTOWN DISTRICT (PADD); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Lake Park, Florida (“Town”) is a municipal corporation of the State of Florida with such power and authority as has been conferred upon it by the Florida Constitution and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town is empowered to enter into contractual arrangements with public agencies, private corporations or other persons; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to solicit consulting firms to provide continuing services on an as needed basis for nine categories of professional services, including planning and engineering; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 23, 2018, the Town received nine responses to its RFQ and a Town Evaluation Committee ranked the nine responses for each of the professional services categories; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution No. 77-11-18, which was approved on November 7, 2018, the Commission approved agreements for continuing professional services with various firms, including Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has entered into a 5-year agreement with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. to provide, in part, planning and engineering services to the Town subject to the issuance of work orders.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK:**

**Section 1.** The whereas clauses are incorporated herein.

**Section 2.** Pursuant to the Town Attorney’s request of the Town Commission at the September 18, 2024 Budget Hearing to authorize the Town Attorney to negotiate a scope of work for planning and engineering studies with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. in the amount of \$50,000 (**see Exhibit “A”**), the Town Manager is hereby authorized to approve a work order agreement in the amount not to exceed \$50,000 for Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. to provide planning and engineering studies. The associated work order agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit “B”**.

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its execution.
