### Summary Explanation/Background:

The Town of Lake Park, Florida, entered into an agreement with DRC Emergency Services, LLC, for Disaster Debris Management and Support Services utilizing the Solid Waste Authority of Palm Beach County's (SWA) competitive bid process (Agreement No. 22-201D) on April 26, 2022.

The initial term was for three (3) years, with an option to renew for an additional three (3) years.

The proposed Amendment No. 1 to the existing Agreement, if approved, would extend the agreement for an additional three (3) years (from May 8, 2025 through May 7, 2028), under the same pricing, terms and conditions.

Note: The proposed Agreement extension would continue to include the following services: debris removal, reduction, and disposal, which are essential to the Town's disaster response and recovery efforts.

The proposed extension would assist in ensuring that the Town continues to maintain access to vital disaster debris management services following an emergency and/or storm event.

The proposed Amendment to the current Agreement was prepared by DRC Emergency Services and reviewed by the Public Works Director, the Interim Finance Director, the Town Attorney and DI Recovery (DIR), the Town's emergency preparedness and response consultants.

The original executed Resolution and Agreement is available in the Town Clerk's Office.
