

RESOLUTION NO. XX-2024 OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE FOR GRANT FUNDS PROVIDED THROUGH THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$29,6563; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City has received notification from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance of its eligibility to apply for assistance under the Fiscal Year 2024 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program via the Local JAG program solicitation; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2024 JAG program allocation of the City has been established by formula in the amount of \$29,653 for eligible local initiatives and activities; and

WHEREAS, the provision of out-of-school programs for at-risk youth is an eligible youth is an eligible prevention and education activity under JAG program guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for Fiscal Year 2024 JAG program funds to support the Literacy Program Specialist position to provide general oversight, management and coordination of the out-of-school literacy, prevention and education programs for at-risk youth at the City's public library and in the community; and

WHEREAS, this will serve a valid public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA, that:

SECTION 1: The City Commission of the City of Lake Worth Beach, Florida, hereby approves the submission of an application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance ("BJA") for grant funds made available through the Fiscal Year 2024 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant program in the amount of \$29,653 to support the Literacy Program Specialist position to provide general oversight, management and coordination of the out-of-school literacy, prevention and education programs for at-risk youth at the City's public library and in the community.

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SECTION 2: The City Commission of the City of Lake Worth Beach, Florida hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Certification and Assurances form once all public comment requirements have been satisfied.

SECTION 3: The City Commission of the City of Lake Worth Beach, Florida hereby authorizes the Interim City Manager to accept the FY JAG award through the JustGrants system upon BJA approval of the City's application.

SECTION 4: Upon execution of the resolution, one copy shall be forwarded to the Leisure Services Director. The fully executed original shall be maintained by the City Clerk as a public record of the City.

SECTION 5: This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
