Action: Amended Motion made by Commissioner Segrich to approve Ordinance No. 2026-09 on first reading with the following changes, adopting the modifications to the definition of dwelling units on line 89; micro units on line 139; to residential uses on line 162; on the use tables removing the additions of underlined c or p for the following uses: boarding houses, community residences type 1 and 2, extended stay and medium intensity extended stay facilities, independent senior living and the last line for bed and breakfast inns; giving direction to staff to have a registration program implemented and to look for a third party management company and for the City Attorney to investigate charging commercial rates for transient housing. **MOTION FAILED FOR LACK OF A SECOND.**
