RESOLUTION NO. 45-2025 OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE CITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$357,312 IN FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOR THE WIMBLEY GYMNASIUM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City desires to make capital improvements to the Wimbley Gymnasium and

WHEREAS, the City has requested that Palm Beach County ("County") make the City's allocation of \$357,312 in Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") "Special Area of Hope" funds available for the Improvements project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed public facility improvements are an eligible use of CDBG funds; and

WHEREAS, the Wimbley Gymnasium is located within the Lake Worth Beach CDBG Target Area; and

WHEREAS, the County has prepared a Capital Improvements Agreement for the Wimbley Gymnasium Improvements project ("Agreement") that sets forth the terms and conditions for the use of these CDBG funds for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into this Capital Improvements Agreement with the County for the purpose of making improvements to the Wimbley Gymnasium; and

WHEREAS, this will serve a valid public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA, that:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The City Commission of the City of Lake Worth Beach, Florida hereby approves the Capital Improvements Agreement between Palm Beach County and the City in the amount of \$357,312 in Fiscal Year 2025-2026 CDBG "Special Area of Hope" funds for public facility improvements to be made to the Wimbley Gymnasium.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The city Commission of the City of Lake Worth Beach, Florida hereby authorizes the Mayor, or her designee, to execute the Capital Improvements Agreement between Palm Beach County and the City and all related documents for this stated purpose.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: Upon execution of the resolution, one copy shall be forwarded to the Leisure Services Department Director. The fully executed original shall be maintained by the City Clerk as a public record of the City.

SECTION 4: This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
