

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO TASK ORDER NO. # 3
CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO TASK ORDER No. X (“Amendment”) is made as of _____, between the **City of Lake Worth Beach**, a Florida municipal corporation located at 7 North Dixie Highway, Lake Worth, Florida 33460 (“City”) and **Teamwork Net.**, a Florida corporation (“CONSULTANT”).

1.0 Project Description:

The City desires the CONSULTANT to provide those services as identified herein and generally described as: 6th Ave Metal Clad Switching Station Engineering Services **Amendment No. 1** (the “Project”).

2.0 Scope

Under this Amendment, the Contractor will provide the City with additional services for the Project as specified in the **Contractor’s Proposal attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “1”**.

3.0 Schedule

The services to be provided under this Amendment shall be completed within 180 calendar days from the City’s approval of this amendment to this Task Order or the issuance of a Notice to Proceed.

4.0 Compensation

This Amendment is issued for a lump sum, not to exceed amount of 29,650.00. This Amendment amends the Task Order 3 in its entirety. The attached proposal identifies all costs and expenses included in the lump sum, not to exceed amount. CONSULTANT shall be solely responsible for any and all amounts which exceed those stated in “Exhibit 1” unless approved in writing by the City.

If there are any conflicts between the terms and conditions of this amendment, this Task Order and the Agreement, the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall prevail.

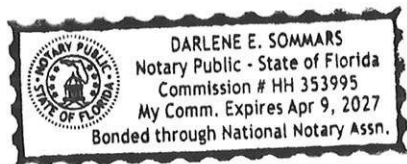
